

LIBELLUS DE SUCCESSIONE PONTIFICIUM AGRIGENTI

A thirteenth century parchment code, was compiled in the bishopric of Raynaldo Acquaviva which contains an inventory of treasure of the cathedral of Agrigento and it also contains information on the churches of Santa Mari di Rifesi and San Michele di Prizzi.

THE LEGEND OF SAN GERLANDO THE ANCIENT RHYTHMIC OFFICE

The manuscript contains three documents

SAN GERLANDO'S LEGEND

it is a precious medieval document that speaks about his life ; the manuscript is from the XIV century and speaks of the saint's body transfer into the cathedral and the transformation of the church into a sanctuary.

THE RHYTHMIC OFFICE

It includes two liturgical celebrations, on February 25 "in festa Sancti Gerlandi" and in "in festo translationis" used in Agrigento church

THE FIRST CATECHISM OF THE AGRIGENTO CHURCH

they are documents bound in the XVIII century, they contain the memory of the oldest catechism of Agrigento church.
